Parent's Guideline Document

- All parents agree to abide by St. Martin's Camogie Club's policies as listed below and policies
 of the Camogie Association.
- Helmets & shin-guards are **compulsory** for training and matches for Health & Safety reasons. All parents must ensure their child wears official St. Martin's gear to matches. Hurls broken only in matches will be replaced.
- Please note only fully paid and registered children can train and play matches with the Club.
- If your child is attending the U6 group you must remain in the field during training / games or designate somebody to take your place.
- All parents are encouraged to develop their Child's Camogie skills in the home also.
- All parents agree to refrain from using negative or foul abusive language during the course of training sessions / matches at all times.
- All parents agree not to enter the field of play / dressing rooms unless directed by selectors / officers of the club. Use of picture/voice capacity mobile phones prohibited in dressing rooms.
- All children must be collected promptly after training.
- Parents agree to their child receiving basic medical attention.
- Parents can consult with coaches about minor issues at an agreed time with the coaches.
- Coaches should deal with guardian complaints / queries in a non-confrontational manner and should be approachable post training / matches.
- For more serious matters parents can contact the Chairperson or Secretary of the Juvenile Camogie Club in confidence.
- Grievances of a serious nature must be notified to the Chairperson in writing as well as verbally.
- All coaches' queries/ requests will be dealt with by the committee of the Juvenile Camogie Club. Day to day queries will be dealt with by the Chairperson or Officers of the Club. Their decision will be binding unless directed by the Senior Club.
- All players will be given as much game time as possible, however at Championship time which is from U14 upwards, the best interests of the team will take precedence.
- I understand the reasons for email and texting and will reply to text messages when requested.
